## LEVEL 3 UNIT PLAN

Lesson Number	Lesson Topic	Lesson Objective
One	What does Allah do	We cannot see Allāh (swt), but we can know many things about Him by understanding what He does. Students will learn about Allāh (swt) based on some of the things He does for the universe and especially for us.
Two	Some names of Allah	Students can know more about Allāh (swt) by studying some of His beautiful names. These names give us a better understanding of Allāh's mode of action and His qualities.
Three	Allah: the Merciful	One of Allāh's most significant qualities is His mercy. Allāh's mercy covers everything. Students will learn why Allāh (swt) is so merciful and how His mercy benefits all of us.
Four	Allah: the Judge	One of the most significant qualities of Allāh (swt) is His Judgment. Allāh (swt) wants all of us to be fair when we deal with others. Students will learn about Allāh's judgment and why we should depend upon His judgment.
Five	We are Muslims	If we want to know someone, we need to know what he does and what he believes. As Muslims, we do certain things and believe in something. Students will learn the few important requirements that make us Muslims.
	Exam One	Covers content in Lessons 1 - 5
Six	Other names of the Qur'an	The Qur'ān has several other names. These names explain some of the unique qualities of the Qur'an. Students should memorize and understand the eight names given in the lesson.
Seven	Hadith	Students will get a basic understanding of the Hadīth. They will learn the names of the major compilers of Hadīth and how many major books of Hadīth are now available.
Eight	Shahadah	Shahadāh is the declaration of our faith in Islam. Students will learn what it means when we declare shahadāh. They will also learn why Shahadāh makes us Muslim.
Nine	Types of salat	There are several types of Salāt performed by a Muslim. Students will learn the basics of different types of Salāt and when these Salāt are performed.
Ten	Why to do salat	Muslims are required to make Salāt for several reasons. Students will learn the importance of Salāt and how doing Salāt makes us better

		Muslims.
	Exam Two	Covers content in Lessons 6 - 10
Eleven	Sawm	Fasting is one of the pillars of Islam. In Arabic, it is called sawm. Students will learn the basics about fasting and its purpose.
Twelve	Charity	The students will learn what zakat is and why giving zakat is a pillar of Islam. They will learn who gets the zakat and how zakat can help the poor.
Thirteen	Hajj	This lesson provides a brief outline of the Hajj and its rituals. Students will also learn a brief history of Ibrahim (A), Isma'il (A), and Hajar. They will also learn the names of the places related to the Hajj.
Fourteen	Prophet (s.a.w) in Makkah	In this lesson, students will learn a brief history of the life of the Prophet (S) when he was in Makkah— from his birth until he migrated to Madinah.
Fifteen	Prophet (s.a.w) in Madinah	In this lesson, students will learn a brief history of the life of the Prophet (S) after he migrated to Madīnah and liberated Makkah. Students will also learn the names of the first three battles fought against the Muslims.
Sixteen	How Rasul (s.a.w) treated others	In this lesson, students will learn about how the Prophet (S) treated people. Many were his companions and many were his enemies. Using a story format, this lesson follows the daily life of the Prophet (S).
	Exam Three	Covers content in Lessons 11 - 16
Seventeen	Ismail (a.s) and Ishaq (a.s)	In this lesson, students will learn about two prophets-Ismail and Ishaq (A)-starting with their birth and their contribution to future generations.
Eighteen	Dawud (a.s)	The life and mission of prophet Dawud (A) is fascinating. Students will learn how Dawud became the king. They will also read a short summary about the major achievements of the prophet.
Nineteen	Isa (a.s)	This lesson provides a short summary of the life and mission of prophet 'Isa (A).
Twenty	Being kind	The teachings of the Qur'ān and the Prophet (S) encourage us to be kind to others. This lesson tells us why being kind to others is a good virtue.
Twenty One	Forgiveness	Allāh (swt) is the most-Forgiving. He forgives our sins and wipes them away if we pray to Him. Allāh (swt) wants us to have the quality of

		forgiveness. In this lesson, students will learn the importance of forgiveness.
Twenty Two	Good deeds	Doing good deeds makes us good Muslims. Belief in Islam is not enough. We must also do good deeds. This lesson explains why we should always do good deeds.
	Exam Four	Covers content in Lessons 17 - 22
Twenty Three	Cleanliness	One of the important teachings of Islam is to be clean. We can be physically clean, but we should also keep our minds clean. This lesson discusses the importance of cleanliness and how we can keep ourselves clean.
Twenty Four	Right Path	The Right Path is the path loved by Allāh (swt). He says we should always follow the Right Path. This lesson discusses the Right Path, how we can know which path is the Right Path, and how to follow that path.
Twenty Five	Muslim family	This lesson discusses some of the characteristics of an ideal Muslim family. Students will learn what a Muslim family does on a daily basis and what makes them good Muslims.
Twenty Six	Perseverance	Islam requires us to show patience and perseverance. Students will learn the importance of perseverance as a main quality of true believers.
Twenty Seven	Punctuality	Timeliness is an important value of Islam. We often ignore the need to be timely in many things we do in life. In this lesson, students will learn why Allāh (swt) encourages us to be punctual in life.
Twenty Eight	Jinn	A jinn is one of Allāh's creatures. We cannot see them because they are invisible beings. This lesson summarizes some of the basic concepts of jinn.
